Gross Motor: Can rise from lying position to sitting			
Stands momentarily alone			
Walks unaided			
Climbs into adult chair Bends down to pick up things without falling over			
Pushes & pulls toys around			
Walks around furniture Goes from standing to sitting by falling onto bottom			
Backs into small chair			
Kneels upright without support			
Can roll a ball & crawl to it			
Fine Motor: Turns several pages of book at one time			
Watches a rolling ball			
Stacks rings over a pole Enjoys messy play, such as finger painting
